**Counting the Omer**

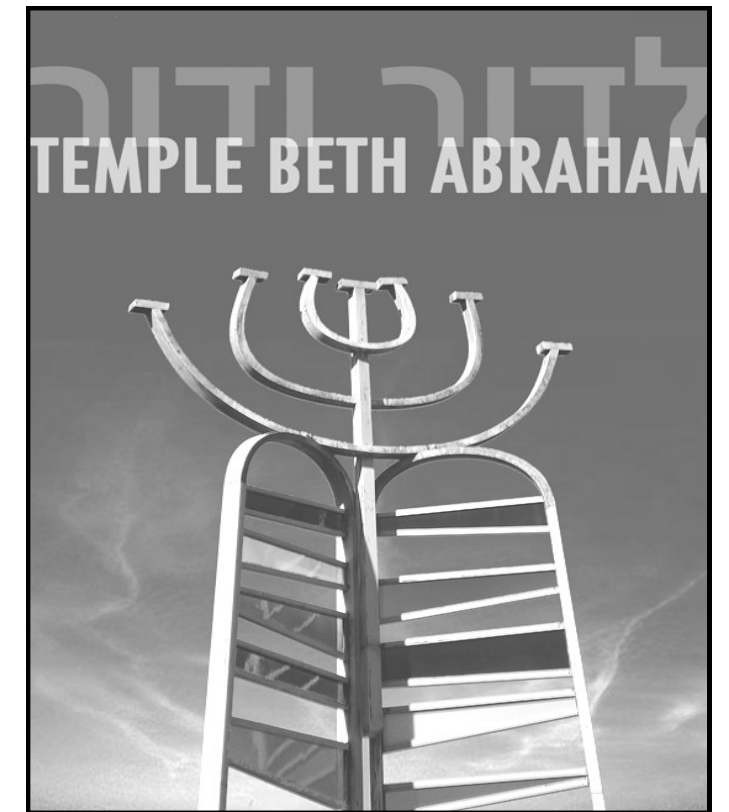

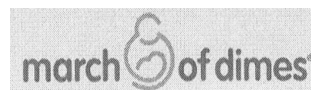

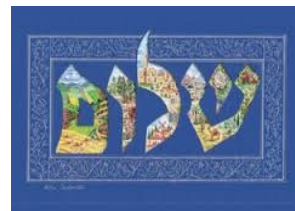
