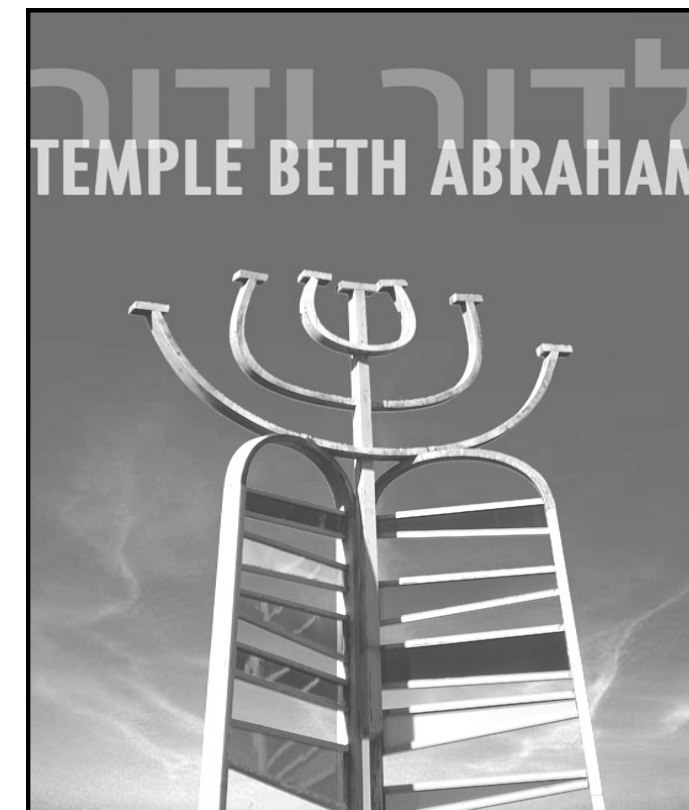
Counting the Omer
