Volunteers are needed to shop, cook, serve, meet-and-greet, host a table and help with arts and crafts. All ages can participate.

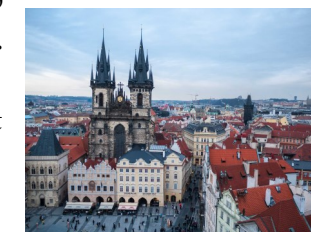
