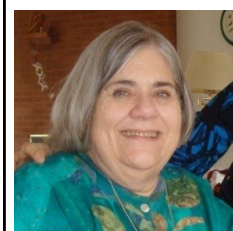
Temple Beth Abraham's mission is to provide our congregants

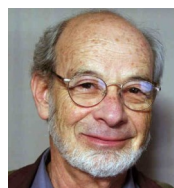
Give Forward to Sharon Abner's Stroke Relief Fund

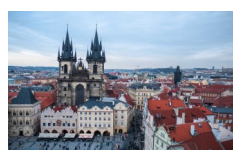
