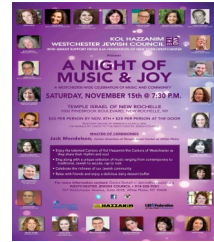


Give Forward to Sharon Abner's Stroke Relief Fund

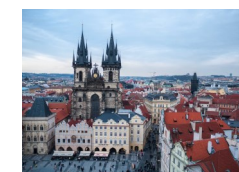
