At the November Board of Trustees meeting, the Dues to Donations Task Force presented their findings.

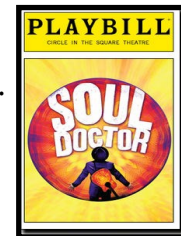

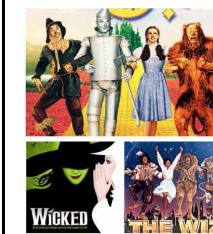
