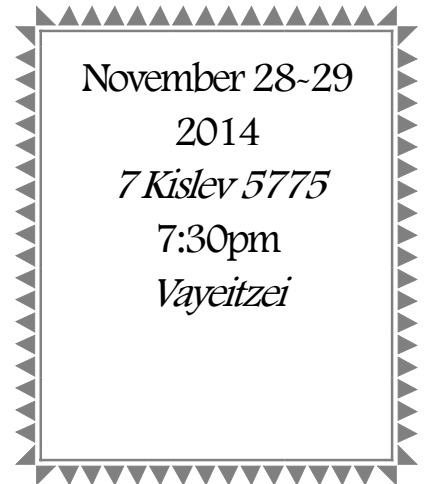

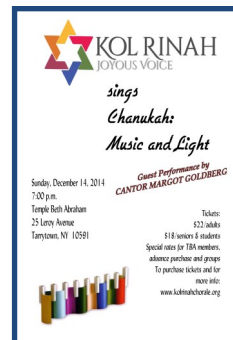

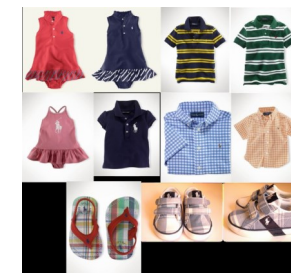
This Chanukah please donate new t-shirts, socks and undergarments for children and teens. Donations are being accepted from **November 24—December 21.**
