Note: In Luganda, a native dialect of Uganda, a vowel sound is often added to the end of words that normally end in a consonant. The Abayudaya have adopted this speech pattern in their pronunciation of modern Hebrew. This song reflects that melding of two cultures, two languages interacting with each other to reveal one universal message—that the strength of God and the Jewish people will live on forever.

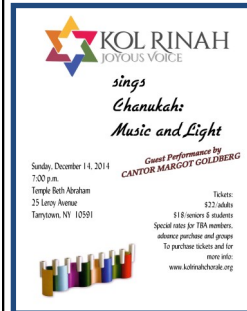

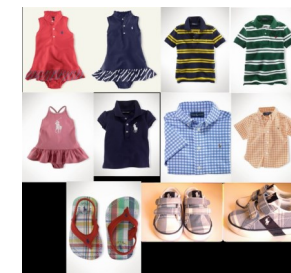
This Chanukah please donate new t-shirts, socks and undergarments for children and teens. Donations are being accepted through **December 21.**
