Saturday, February 7 from 9:00am-noon in Elmsford**

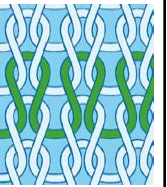


A fantastic hands-on volunteer activity for the whole family including children and teens. Volunteering will vary and include sorting and packing donated food and repacking food items or packing backpacks.

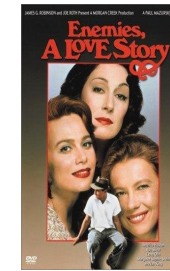
