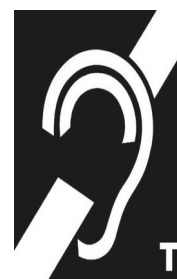

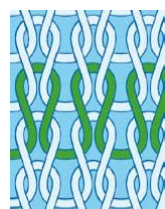
Mark you calendars—Shabbaton Weekend—October 23-25, 2015

The group will start a new project of creating beautiful items for various causes and have fun knitting together! Supplies are available, but any donations of yarn and knitting needles are always appreciated.

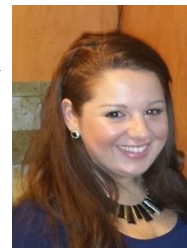

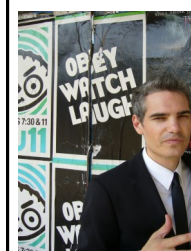
