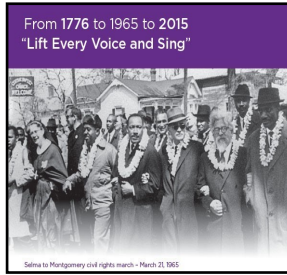

**Be Part of the Torah Reading for the High Holydays!**

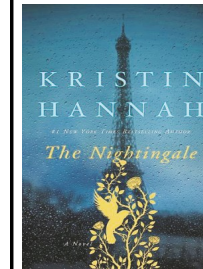
Though the Summer is just beginning, we're already working on the High Holydays.

**Friday, July 10 at 10:00am**



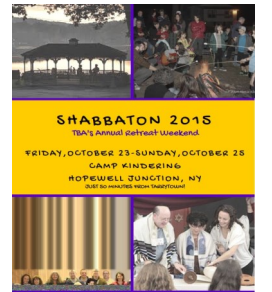
