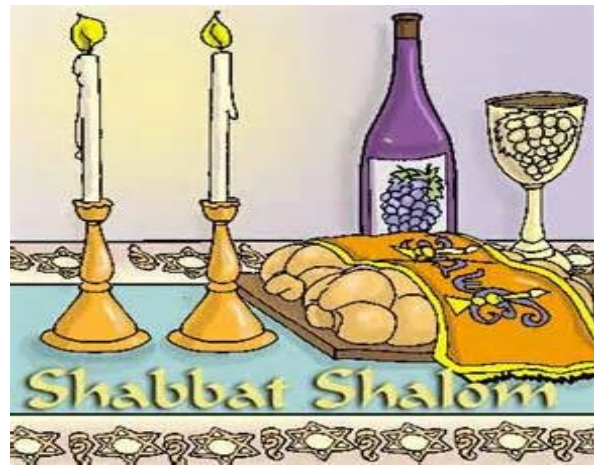

You do not have to read or prepare anything in advance. Life experience is the only tool you'll need.

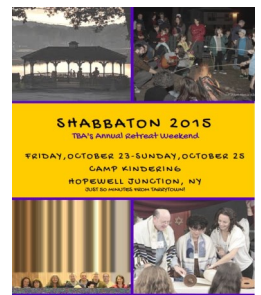
Stessa Peers will be leading this month's discussion about Jewish women's religiosity post-1492: power, strength and supernatural events.
