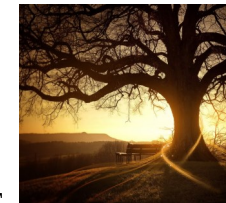


The Next Book Club Discussion:

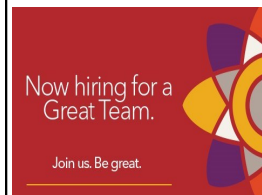
Wise Aging Group—Save the Dates!
