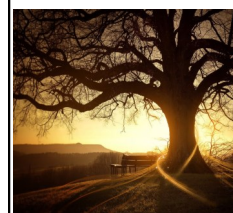
#### The Next Book Club Discussion: Friday, September 11 at 10:00am
