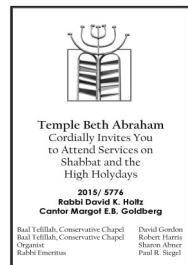
The program will be geared toward adults and children over 10 (who must be accompanied by their parents). No babysitting will be available at the JCC on the Hudson.

Begin the High Holydays on a high note and make them more meaningful.

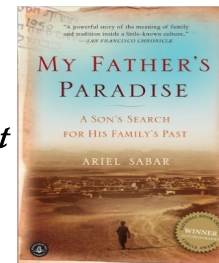

Wednesday, September 16 from 7:00-8:00pm



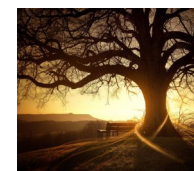
