The Main Office will be closed for **Sukkot** on Monday, September 28 and Tuesday September 29.



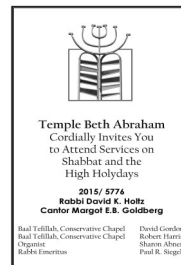
**Volunteers Needed to Usher or Greet
