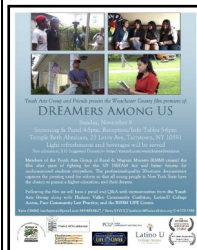
Mark your calendars for a morning of family fun and a chance to shop for your Chanukah gifts at TBA!

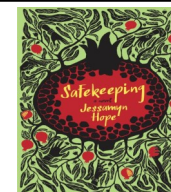
