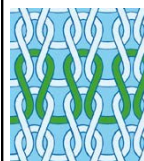
**Movie Mavens Presents: *Putzel*

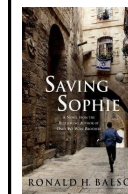

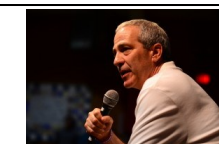
***Saving Sophie* by Ronald H. Balson**
