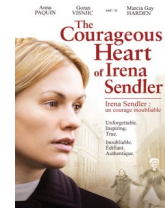

Hamburgers and hot dogs with all the fixins' will be served! Dinners are by reservation only and are accepted along with payment as the RSVP.

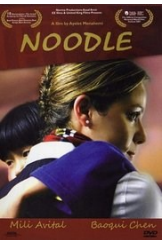

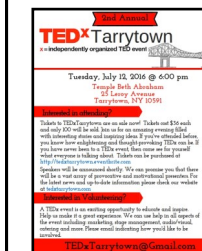
