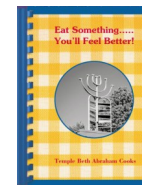


**Scholar-in-Residence —Yiscah Smith**

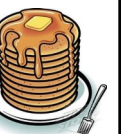
**Movie Mavens Presents: A Borrowed Identity**
