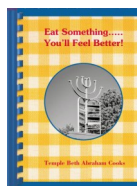

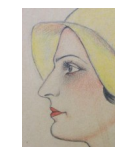

Starting Wednesday, February 8

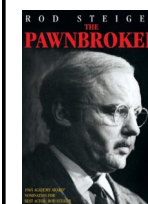
Join fellow congregants to create art in a relaxed, supportive environment. Whether you're a seasoned artist or haven't done an art project since elementary school, this is the workshop for you!
