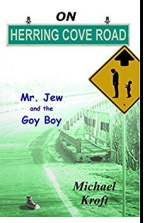

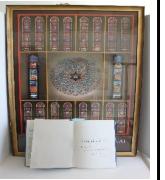


**Movie Mavens Presents: Seven Minutes in Heaven

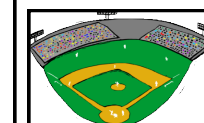
