Wednesday, April 5 at 7:30pm**

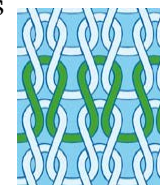

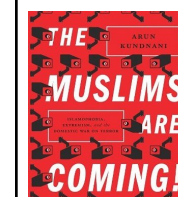
Passover is Coming
