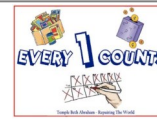

TBA is once again repurposing the ancient ritual of counting the 49 days of the *Omer* between Passover and *Shavuot*. By collecting *tzedakah* to feed the hungry, we re-imagine an ancient ritual to remind us of the important connection between Exodus and the giving of Torah, to gain a deepened spiritual sense of gratitude, and to provide a way for our congregational family to celebrate and participate in repairing the world.

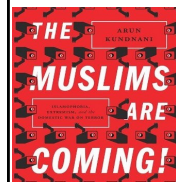

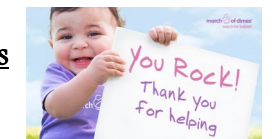
