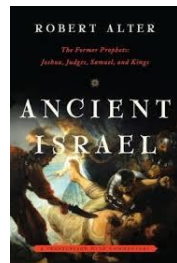
**Honey From The Heart**

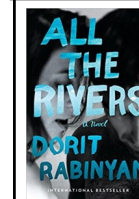
