At the High Holydays, Rabbi Holtz spoke about what constitutes a "*machloket l'shem shamayim*" - an argument for the sake of heaven. He said polarization of opinions and positions which we are experiencing in our country today has long been a feature of human discourse, though the animosity we're now seeing has not. TBA is honored to be piloting the curriculum from Israel's Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies. We look at Jewish texts on one aspect of how to conduct an argument and then have the opportunity to put that idea into practice. Please join fellow congregants in a skills-building program on how to turn your disagreements into arguments for the sake of heaven.

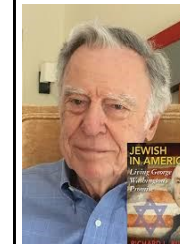

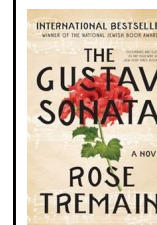
