Q. Does this work like the Purim gift baskets (mishloach manot)?

Does everyone at TBA receive a jar of honey?

A. No. This fundraiser does not work like mishloach manot. Not everyone will receive a jar of honey (although you can send one to yourself!) It is not internal to TBA congregants and since we don't want anyone to end up with 20 jars of honey, we encourage you to send honey to those outside of our congregation.

Q. What do you get for \$12.00?

A. Every \$12.00 you spend sends a jar of honey to the person of your choice. Each jar comes with a lovely note wishing the recipient a happy and sweet New Year while informing them that a donation has been made in their honor to TBA's Tikkun Olam Fund.

Q. Who can we send the honey to?

A. Anyone! Friends, family, colleagues - across the street, across the country, around the world! What a sweet and wonderful way to wish all the special people in your lives a happy New Year!

Q. Do you pay extra for shipping?

A. The \$12.00 includes everything for all orders placed before midnight, July 11 and sent within the continental U.S.! For honey sent overseas, there will be an additional shipping charge.

Q. When are order forms due in by?

A. Order forms are due in to the Temple office by July 7. Or you can order online through the holidays at TBA's website, <http://www.tba-ny.org/honey> and click on the honey link. Orders placed online after July 11 will incur an additional \$5.00/jar shipping fee. Orders placed after August 15 may not arrive before Rosh Hashanah.
