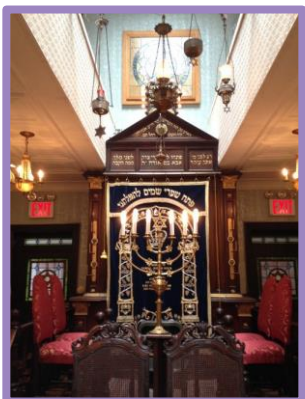

*Kehila Kedosha Janina* on Broome Street, is the last remaining Romanite synagogue in the Western Hemisphere and a New York City landmark.

The Romanites are a community of Greek Jews more than 2,000 years old. They came to the U.S. starting in the early 1900s; the synagogue on the Lower East Side opened in 1927.
