

TBA High Holiday Ticket FAQ for Non-Members and Guests

? I am not affiliated with a synagogue. Can I buy tickets?

You **can**, for yourself and your dependent children (under 25 living at home). Guest tickets are \$400 per ticket for adults (13 years of age or older).

? I belong to another synagogue. Can I get tickets through reciprocity?

Yes! If your current synagogue is affiliated with the Reform or Conservative movements, offers reciprocity, and provides a letter confirming you're in good standing, you can receive tickets for yourself and your dependent children under 25.

? Do full-time students get tickets?

Yes. Full-time students up to age 28 can receive tickets. A note from your school verifying enrollment is required.

? We just got married. Can we get tickets?

If one of you is the child of a TBA member, you've been married less than one year, and the older spouse is under 35—you're eligible for tickets.

? If I buy tickets now and decide to join TBA later, do I get credit?

Yes! If you buy High Holiday tickets as a non-affiliated adult and join TBA before **December 31** of this fiscal year, we'll deduct the ticket cost from your annual commitment!
